## Lockyer Valley cooking masterclass delivers star experience for foodies and home cooks

Passionate foodies and home cooks descended on the Lockyer Valley on Sunday to learn the tricks of the trade in a contemporary afternoon tea masterclass.

Treasury Brisbane Executive Sous Chef Trevor Winch and The Star Gold Coast Nineteen at The Star Executive Chef Kelvin Andrews used local ingredients in their specifically-created dishes, including cheese and yoghurt from Awassi Cheesery and persimmons from Blackboy Ridge.

Mr Winch showed the participants how to make a Grantham cheese, pumpkin and tomato rosti with an avocado and lime salsa.

"It's been a great opportunity being invited by Council to take part in this initiative and share my passion, skills and knowledge with the broader community," Mr Winch said.
