"Will & Flow features a sleek and breezy design, offering indoor and outdoor seating for guests, and the chance to soak up the best of Brisbane all-year round.

"Whether you're craving a craft-brewed coffee after a walk, a delicious cocktail after work, or looking to book a gorgeous waterfront venue for that special occasion, Will & Flow has got you covered."

Mr Dodt said 2020 had been a year of challenge and uncertainty for most, but the opening of the property's first overwater bar was a pleasing milestone after 25 years of operation.

"While we're still working in line with social distancing restrictions, Will & Flow will be able to initially cater for up to 45 guests seated and up to 70 guests cocktail-style," Mr Dodt said.

"People will be able to create unforgettable memories in the stylish and panoramic outdoor river setting or relax in the intimate and exquisite atmosphere of our indoor boutique bar.

"It's perfect timing as we head into the festive season where friends, families, work colleagues, and other kindred groups can still celebrate in a safe and vibrant atmosphere."
