Request for trading halt
The Star Entertainment Group Limited (ASX code: SGR) – Listing Rule 17.1

The Star Entertainment Group Limited (ASX code: SGR) (**The Star**) requests that an immediate trading halt be applied to its ordinary shares in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1.

The trading halt is requested pending an expected announcement in connection with certain determinations regarding disciplinary action expected to be given by the Queensland Attorney-General and the Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation (OLGR).

The trading halt is necessary as otherwise trading in securities may take place in an uninformed market.

The Star requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier time of the announcement referred to above and the commencement of trading on Tuesday, 13 December 2022.

The Star is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, nor is it aware of any other information required to be provided to the market or ASX in relation to the trading halt.
